The wider objective of the project is to promote building a society with high legal literacy and ability to improve the legal system in the Russian Federation based on the values and principles of European Union law and European human rights system.

The ProEU project aims at:

- enhancing skills of BA law students in applying European Union law and policy through the new module "Protection of Human Rights within and across the European Union" (54 hours)
- spreading knowledge about the European human rights system to different target groups through the set of courses (8-hour training course "Challenges in monitoring and protecting human rights in the European Union and the Russian Federation" for non-law students, 16-hour professional training course "European Union practices of protecting human rights in criminal proceedings" for legal professionals, public administrators, civil society), Winter School of Law "Academia Legis" for schoolchildren and forum "EU Human Rights Policy"
- increasing the research capacity of students, teachers and researchers at PSU and upgrading skills of young researchers in exploring human rights law in the EU through the Published book "Good governance in the European Union"
- facilitating interaction among the academic, legal, political and social communities by means of the university-wide network
