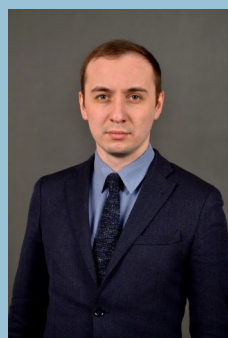
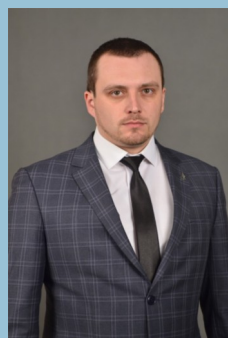

3. Differences between European and Russian insight into human rights (4 hours)

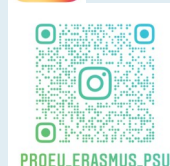
**Learning outcomes:**
